

## Lecture Attendance Is Required

### Bonus Points Are Proportional to Lecture Attendance

You enrolled in an on-campus class scheduled to meet on Monday and Wednesday for a two-hour lecture and a ninety-minute lab session. Attendance is required. You need to be come to class prepared so you can participate in lecture and lab activities.

You will need to turn in your chapter study guide homework assignments at the start of the lab session. These documents are used to monitor your attendance. The bonus points awarded will be proportional to your attendance record. If you do all the homework but only attend half of the lab/lecture sessions, then you will be awarded half of the bonus points.

If you do not attend class, then I can not help you learn anatomy and physiology . If you are not in class, then you can not participate in class activities and you can not help other students learn anatomy and physiology

Is it possible to earn an “A” without coming to lab/lecture session? Yes, but it is unlikely. I have taught this class many years and here is what I have learned. It is only the students who come to class that pass the class and earn an “A”.
